Why do we need you?

Maggie's is looking for enthusiastic and friendly volunteers to come along and help with bucket collections on each day of the Johnnie Walker championship at Gleneagles from the 26-29 August 2010.

The Elizabeth Montgomerie Foundation, set up by Colin Montgomerie in memory of his mother, is supporting Maggie's and funding the building of the centre in Lanarkshire. Through the foundation Maggie's has the opportunity to collect donations from spectators at the Johnnie Walker Championships.

What will I be doing?

Volunteers will be based on collection stations or walking round dedicated areas of the golf course on each day of the championship collecting donations from spectators for Maggie's.

What skills and attributes do I need?

For this role you will ideally have:

- A good level of fitness as volunteers will be required to walk around the golf course carrying collecting buckets
- Lots of enthusiasm
- Sense of humour
- An interest in golf

How much time do I need to commit?

Volunteers are required to work one full day from 10am till 5pm. Lunch and refreshments will be provided on the day.

What support will I be given?

You will be contacted before the event to discuss any queries and will receive a full briefing about the roles. A team leader from Maggie's will brief, guide, support and work closely with you on the day.

What benefits can I expect?

- The satisfaction of knowing that you are making a valuable contribution to Maggie's Cancer Caring Centres across the UK
- Lunch and refreshments will be provided on the day of volunteering
- If volunteering for a day then volunteers will receive a season ticket for the whole tournament (including parking)
- Maggie's volunteers do not receive any payment for their work but are able to claim expenses so they are not out of pocket. For example, volunteers can claim previously agreed travel expenses and, if devoting a full day to the charity, the cost of a sandwich lunch.
